SCHOOL CROSSING SAFETY

School Crossing Supervisors are employed by the Transport Department. The supervisors for Mueller College work the crossing in the mornings from 7:45am to 8:45am and in the afternoons from 3:00pm to 3:30pm. All students (and parents with children) crossing Morris Road are asked to use the crossing at these times.

When the Supervisor has placed the "Children Crossing" signs, pedestrians are to wait behind the yellow line until the Supervisor is in place in the middle of the road with the STOP sign and blows the whistle. When the whistle blows pedestrians are to cross between the red and white poles. When the signs are taken down the Supervisor can no longer allow pedestrians to cross under his/her supervision.

Cyclists must dismount to cross. Students are **NOT** to play with bouncing balls on the footpath or surrounding roads.

Motorists parking or setting down or picking up passengers **PLEASE DO NOT USE** the "No Standing" zones. **Bus zones must be kept clear at all times**. The Morris Road speed limit is 40kph at all times.

PLEASE SUPPORT THE SUPERVISORS. USE THE CROSSING CORRECTLY. YOUR CHILD'S SAFETY DEPENDS ON IT.
