## Secondary Twilight Swimming Carnival 2022

Mueller's annual Secondary Swimming Carnival will be taking place this term. This Carnival will allow students the opportunity to record a time for selection into the school team for the District Carnival in 2023.

Date:	Thursday 27 October 2022
Time:	3:30pm – 8:30pm
Destination:	Deception Bay Aquatic Centre, Maine Terrace
Transport:	Students may arrive by private transport to the venue, or alternatively, catch one of the school busses from Mueller College to the venue. If your child intends to catch the school bus to the venue, you must accept the 'BUS TRANSPORT for Secondary Swimming Carnival 2022' event on Parent Portal.
Sign Out:	All students must be signed out by a guardian <b>before leaving the venue</b> . Alternatively, students may provide a signed/dated permission note to leave the venue <b>upon completion of the carnival</b> . All students must be picked up from the venue, as there is NO bus service returning to Mueller.
Uniform:	Mueller sport uniform/house colours - <u>Students are strongly encouraged to dress</u> <u>in their house colours</u> . When students attend carnivals wearing their house colours it significantly improves house and team spirit. House shirts can be purchased from the School Locker at North Lakes. If students are unsure of their house they will be able to check with their form class teacher.
Team Selection/ Age Champion:	Please note that students will be competing at this Carnival for the 2023 Age Champion and selection into the school team that will represent Mueller at the 2023 District Carnival
Exemptions:	Students who are injured/unwell may be eligible to submit an exemption form for selection into the school swim team <b>prior</b> to the commencement of the carnival. Bring:	Appropriate Swimming Attire, Towel, Water, Food, Money for BBQ / Canteen.
Note:	Whilst not compulsory, attendance is encouraged as there are a range of events from swimming to compete for selection in the school team to represent Mueller at the District carnival, to novelty and swimming events. There will be a BBQ run by the service team, as well as a Coffee Van available.

Medical information for your student will be based on the existing data that we have recorded in the College database. Parents are encouraged to regularly check the online Parent Lounge and update medical details as required. If your student requires medication during these activities, please fill in the Over the Counter/Short Term Medication Order request form that is found on the College website or collect from Student Services or the Health Room.
